## **BSR INTERREG III B PARTNER SEARCH FORUM**

In Vilnius, Lithuania 23 – 24 May 2005

This information is providing you with the Final Draft Programme, the Registration Form and all practical details for being able to register as participant at the Forum.

A special opportunity for participants from the Russia and Belarus has been offered by the organiser in order to support to cover their travel costs for a number of participants from each of these countries (See further details below).

The Baltic Sea Region's INTERREG III B Joint Secretariat in close co-operation with the Ministry of Interior of Lithuania invites interested project owners to meet potential partners and collect information on funding options for project ideas that seek for EU financial contribution for the transnational cooperation in the BSR.

The Partner Search Forum in Vilnius aims at fostering and supporting preparation of joint projects on themes that are of high relevance of the BSR INTERREG III B Neighbourhood Programme (Programme) in its fourth year of implementation.

#### Focus of the Forum

The focus of the two-day event will be on project presentation and discussions in parallel *project development sessions*, related to the missing themes of the following BSR INTERREG III B Neighbourhood Programme priorities and measures:

# Priority 2 Promotion of territorial structures supporting sustainable BSR development

- ♦ Measure 2.1.: **Promoting balanced polycentric settlement structures**
- Measure 2.2.: Creating sustainable communication links for improved spatial integration (transport and communication)
- Measure 2.3.: Enhancing good management of cultural and natural heritage and of natural resources

# Priority 3.: Transnational and bilateral institution and capacity building. In the Baltic Sea Region

- ♦ Measure 3.1. **Promotion of transnational institution and capacity building**
- ♦ Measure 3.2. Bilateral maritime cooperation across the Baltic Sea

The particular emphasis of the Forum will also be placed on enhancement of joint initiatives that promote east – west integration and, in particular, involvement of eligible regions of Belarus and Russia in the BSR cooperation.

In addition to the practical advice on project application conditions, thematic expert contributions will be delivered on experience on methods/approaches in spatial planning and regional development policy design and implementation in the BSR along



respective priorities and measures.
