- municipal co-operation (joint services, common development activities, exchange of best practice),
- local co-operation contacts (networks and durable contacts, regular events, people-to-people activities), als training (networks and staff training) is eligible activity.

The eligible area of the North priority covers following territories:

- in Estonia: Ida-Viru, Jõgeva, Tartu, Põlva, Võru, Valga, Viljandi, Pärnu, Lääne, Saare, Hiiu;
- In Latvia: Kurzeme, Latgale, Riga, Vidzeme, Zemgale;
- In Russia: Leningrad and Pskov oblast, St Petersburg.

Applicants can be municipalities, regional authorities, schools, universities, municipal enterprises, non profit organizations and under certain conditions also private bodies. At least two partners from two countries have to be involved in the project.

The INTERREG IIIA priority North is financed from the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF). The total ERDF budget available for the Priority for the tim period 2004 - 2006 amounts to EUR 7 840 236. The maximum cofinancing rate being 75% of the total eligible project costs. Expected project size is from 5000 to 1 million Euro of ERDF funding.

The first call for proposals for the INTERREG IIIA Priority South supporting cross-border cooperation between Latvia, Lithuania and Belarus is launched on October 1, 2004 with the deadline for project submission on November 15, 2004.

The objective of the South Priority is to utilise the crossborder co-operation potential in order to facilitate the socioeconomic development of the cross-border co-operation territory. The following activities are eligible:

- Tourism development: (planning, improvement of infrastructure, services, marketing) etc.;
- Business development along the transit corridors: (strategies, advise on import/export, exchange of experience, business contacts and networks) etc.;
- Accessibility across the borders: (infrastructure, joint planning of public services, information services, early warning systems) etc.;
- Preserving the environment: (cross- border monitoring systems and management of resources, planning cross-border infrastructure, co-operation for emergency cases) etc.;
- People-to-people activities: (facilitation of contacts and networks, joint training activities, joint studies) etc.

- In Belarus: Vitebsk, Minsk and Grodno oblasts.
